

Trees available from the National Arbor Day Foundation

Tall Trees 50' plus with no overhead wires:

Native: **Red Maple** (*Acer rubrum*) Bare root 3-4'
Very successful tree much loved by birds year round. Wet or dry soils.

Native: **American Sweetgum** (*Liquidambar styraciflua*) Bare root 2-3' Moist soil. Gorgeous fall colors.

Native: **Black Gum/Tupelo** (*Nyssa sylvatica*)
Bare root 1-1 ½' Slow growing. Salt tolerant. Can take wet soil. Beautiful fall colors.

Native: **Swamp White Oak** (*Quercus bicolor*)
Potted 1 ½' Salt tolerant. Slow growing. Moist soil.

Native: **White Oak** (*Quercus alba*) Bare root 2-3'
or potted 1 ½' Salt tolerant. Considered the most valuable host tree for wildlife in N. America.

Native: **Northern Red Oak** (*Quercus rubra*) Bare root 2-3' or potted 1 ½' – 2' Salt tolerant. Grows fast. Beautiful, classical shape. [Plant bare root version in fall.](#)

Native: **White Spruce** (*Picea glauca*) Bare root 6" to 1' or potted 2'-3'. Evergreen. Classical Christmas tree shape. Grows fast.

Native: **Northern Catalpa** (*Catalpa speciosa*) Bare root 2-3' Very tough in urban street conditions. Grows fast. Magnificent white flowers and very large heart shaped leaves.

Native: **Pin Oak** (*Quercus palustris*) Bare root 2-3' Salt tolerant. Very tough. Grows fast. Beautiful shape and does not cast thick shade. Beautiful fall color. [Plant in fall.](#)

Native: **Hackberry** (*Celtis occidentalis*) Bare root 2-3' or potted 1 ½' – 2' Very tough in salt or wind. Berries. Can tolerate some shade. Salt tolerant. Not wet soil. Grows fast. [Plant bare root version in fall.](#)

Medium/small sized trees:

Native: Downy **Serviceberry** (*Amelanchier arborea*) Bare root 2-3' Early spring flowers. Moist to dry soil. Can tolerate some shade. 20-30' tall.

Native: **Eastern Redbud** (*Cercis canadensis*) Bare root 3-4' Brilliant pink flowers before leaves come out. Can tolerate shade. [Plant in fall.](#) 12-25' tall.

Native: **Eastern Red Cedar** (*Juniperus virginiana*) Bare root 6" – 1' or potted 10". Evergreen, very tough. 15-35' tall.

Flowering Crabapple (*Malus 'Sargentii' or Snowdrift*) Bare root 2-3'. Flowers. Very hardy. 20' tall.

Native: **Washington Hawthorn** (*Crataegus phaenopyrum*) Bare root 2-3' Flowers. Not wet ground. [Plant in fall.](#) 25-30' tall.

Tall bushes:

Native: **Arrowwood Viburnum** (*Viburnum dentatum*) Bare root 1-1 ½' Beautiful white flowers and beautiful berries and nice leaf color in fall. Moist to dry. 12' tall.

Native: **American Cranberrybush Viburnum** (*Viburnum opulus L. var. americanum Aiton*) Bare root 1-1 ½' Beautiful flowers and brilliant red translucent berries which birds love. Very tough. 12' tall.
